



### **Milford over Lakeland in final Soccer Match**

Milford and Lakeland played another close and hard-fought game in their final soccer match-up as KVC rivals before the restructuring of the league next year, with Milford taking both games of the year with 1-0 scores. Milford's recent streak hits 7-01 since early April.

The first half played fairly even, with both teams getting some scoring opportunities. Lakeland's offense put some pressure on the Milford defense with a series of corner kicks and pressure, when senior co-captain Paige Schwartz sent a corner kick to the Milford junior keeper Angie Pasciolla, who stopped the long ball, but it bounded out to Sophomore Amy Carlton for a point blank shot, which was off the post. Junior Kelly Miller also got stopped on a scoring opportunity. Milford scored an apparent goal, when sophomore Michelle Dant passed from the end line back to senior tri-captain Allie Zemaitis in the box, who shot past Eagle junior keeper Sam Miller, but Dant stepped out-of-bounds before the pass.

The Mavericks came out quickly in the second half and put pressure on the Lakeland defense. In the first minute, Sophomore Strikers Ryan Winn and Dant moved the ball into the Eagle end, initially stopped by the Lakeland defense, but Winn gathered the ball back, and moved into the box and shot to the far post past the Eagle keeper Miller. Both teams had some limited offensive pressure, but both defenses tightened up to stop the attacks. Lakeland's Dahl and freshman Stephanie Lock played strong for the Eagles in the half. Milford's defense, led by seniors tri-captains Chelsea Shrewsbury and Erica Adams, sophomores Cara Johnson and Tess Zasuwa, and junior Shannon Dunn, along keeper Pasciolla, held on for their fifth shutout of the year.

Lakeland lost on Saturday to South Lyon, 1-0, with their record at 1-11-3 overall (0-8-2 in the KVC). Milford lost to Novi on Friday night 7-0, with their record at 7-6-1 (5-4-1 in the KVC).
